EVACUATION ORDER IN PLACE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

EVACUATION ORDER – August 1, 2022, 1400HRS Green Mountain Road in the vicinity of IR#12, 12a 110 GREEN MOUNTIAN ROAD

An Evacuation ORDER has been issued by the Lower Similkameen Indian Band Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen and the due to the threat of a wildfire.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Lower Similkameen Indian Band Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen And has issued an EVACUATION ORDER for the following areas:

- IR#12, 12a
- 110 Green mountain road
- Green Mountain Road between Highway 3A to the south and Apex Mountain Road to the north and in the general vicinity of Ford Lake, and as shown on Schedule 2.

An Evacuation order has been issued and you must leave the area immediately.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area immediately.
- Follow directions of emergency responders and travel designated or safest route available.
