EVACUATION ALERT

South East Skwish Creek

April 18, 2023 15:38

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by Ts'kw'aylaxw First Nation at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Ts'kw'aylaxw First Nation has issued an Evacuation Alert for the following areas:

Pavilion Indian Reserve #1

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

Request anyone who would like to evacuate due to smoke or health concerns please come to the Ts'kw'aylaxw First Nation gymnasium at 35100 Highway 99N to register.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call Rose Adolph, 250-457-0663
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor on Tskwaylaxw Facebook page for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.
