EVACUATION ALERT

July 20, 2023, at 16:30 hrs [EAST ADAMS LAKE WILDFIRE]

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC), effective July 20, 2023, at 16:30 hrs. A current wildfire in Lower Adams Lake poses a potential threat to life & property for Adams Lake Indian Reserve I.R. 1 - Cstèlen (Hustalen).

An Evacuation Alert is a warning about a potential threat to life and/or property. It is intended to give you time to prepare for a **possible** evacuation. Residents will be given as much notice as possible prior to an actual evacuation, however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

What You Should Do:

Upon Notification of an Alert...

- Locate all family members. Designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area (in case an Evacuation Order is called while separated).
- Pack essential items such as govt-issued ID & valuable papers (e.g., birth certificates, status cards), medications, eyeglasses, immediate care needs for family members or pets. If time & space permit, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Arrange accommodation & transportation for all members of the residence, if possible. Fill gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Prepare to move elders, disabled persons, children and/or neighbors if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you & move livestock to a safe area (if possible).

Wait for an **Evacuation Order** to be issued before evacuating. Monitor for information on evacuation orders & location of Reception Centers.
