

EVACUATION ORDER

2023-07-01 at 1600 Hours

Pursuant to the *Emergency Program Act*, an Evacuation Order has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to a wildfire on Knox Mountain Park.

Because of the potential danger to life and health safety, the City of Kelowna has issued an Evacuation Order for all properties on the following streets:

- CHAPIN RD
- HERBERT HEIGHTS RD
- KNOX MOUNTAIN DR
- POPLAR POINT DR

Members of the local police department and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

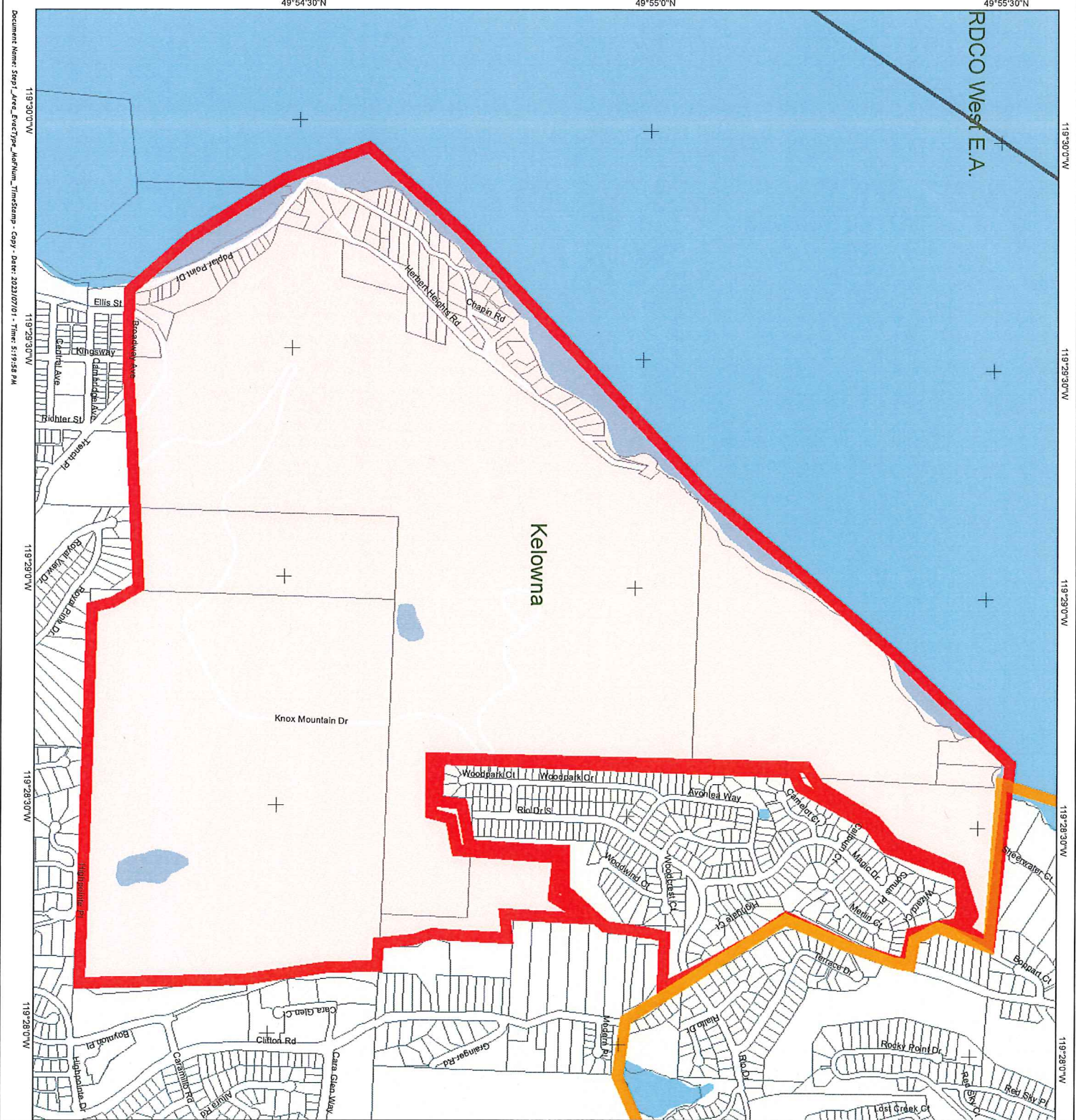
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area immediately
- Register at the ESS Reception Centre at Salvation Army (1480 Sutherland Avenue) in Kelowna
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family; take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (i.e. medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available
- Take pets in pet kennels or on leash
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service

Knox Mountain Fire Evacuation Order (23-4498) Poplar Point & Knox Mnt

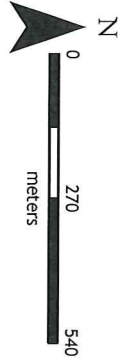
