



EVACUATION ALERT

Lhoosk'uz Dené Territory

July 12th 2023 7:00 PM

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation *has* issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas:

Lhoosk'uz Area, from its borders with the Regional Districts of Bulkley Nechako and Fraser-Fort George and extending south to points near the Kluskus Lakes and Tsacha Lake.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- All members report to the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation Band Office, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you.
- Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation Operations Manager Jeana Moore @ 250-255-1948 or via Facebook Messenger.
- Arrangements for accommodations will be made by the Nation.
- The Nation will notify community members of an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation and Lhoosk'uz Strong Facebook pages and check your Facebook messenger for updates and for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.

Further information will be issued on an ongoing basis via Facebook and or Messenger.
