

EVACUATION ALERT ADAMS LAKE I.R. 2 (SQUAAM 2)

August 7, 2023, at 10:30 hrs BUSH CREEK EAST WILDFIRE [K21633]

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Adams Lake Indian Band Emergency Operations Centre (ALIB EOC), effective **August 7**, 2023, at 10:30am. The Bush Creek East Wildfire poses a potential threat to life & property for **Adams Lake Indian Reserve I.R. 2** (Squaam 2).

An **Evacuation Alert** is a warning about a potential threat to life and/or property. It is intended to give you time to prepare for a possible evacuation. Residents will be given as much notice as possible prior to an actual evacuation, however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

What You Should Do:

Upon Notification of an Alert...

- Locate all family members. Designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area (in case an Evacuation Order is called while separated).
- Pack essential items such as govt-issued ID & valuable papers (e.g., birth certificates, status cards), medications, eyeglasses, immediate care needs for family members or pets. If time & space permit, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Arrange accommodation & transportation for all members of the residence, if possible. Fill gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Prepare to move elders, disabled persons, children and/or neighbors if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you & move livestock to a safe area (if possible).

Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor for information on evacuation alert changes & the Reception Center.

Effective immediately: Adams Lake Indian Reserve I.R. 2 (Squaam 2) is now on EVACUATION ALERT status.

Adams Lake Indian Reserve I.R. 1 - Cstèlen (Hustalen) REMAINS on EMERGENCY ORDER status
