BUSH CREEK EAST WILDFIRE [K21633]

An **Emergency Order** has been issued by the Adams Lake Indian Band Chief & Council ("Chief & Council") and Adams Lake Indian Band Emergency Operations Centre ("EOC"), effective **August** 2023, at 1218. The Bush Creek East wildfire [K21633] poses a significant threat to life & property for **Adams Lake Indian Reserve I.R. 5** 

# What is an Emergency Order?

An **Emergency Order** is an indication of significant threat to life and/or property. Residents may have limited notice of this Emergency Order due to swiftly changing conditions.

# When is an Emergency Order Used?

An Emergency Order is utilized by Chief & Council and the EOC to facilitate the safe evacuation of residents from their homes, prohibit travel into the area for public safety, and enter private property when an emergency threatens lives, property, or the environment within Adams Lake Indian Band's jurisdiction.

## What Should You Do?

### Upon Notification of an Order...

- Locate all family members. The designated meeting area outside the evacuation area is *McArthur Island Park Reception Centre, Kamloops*.
- *If approved by EOC personnel,* pack essential items such as govt-issued ID & valuable papers (e.g., birth certificates, status cards), medications, eyeglasses, immediate care needs for family members or pets.
- Assist elders, disabled persons, children and/or neighbors if needed.
- Leave the area immediately. Follow the directions of EOC officials and evacuate using the route they've identified. Do not return home until you've been advised that the Emergency Order has been rescinded.
- Monitor for updates on the Emergency Order & Reception Center.
