

EVACUATION ORDER

August 17, 2023 at 13:00 Hours

Pursuant to the *Emergency Program Act*, an Evacuation Order has been issued by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to wildfire.

Because of the potential danger to life and health safety, the City of West Kelowna has issued an Evacuation Order for the following properties:

- All properties accessed off of Bear Creek road north of Parkinson road including:
 - Dougmac Road
 - Petterson Road
 - Rose Valley Road
 - 1045 Bear Creek Road
- 2740 Smith Creek Road
- 2850 Dixie Road

Members of the local police department and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

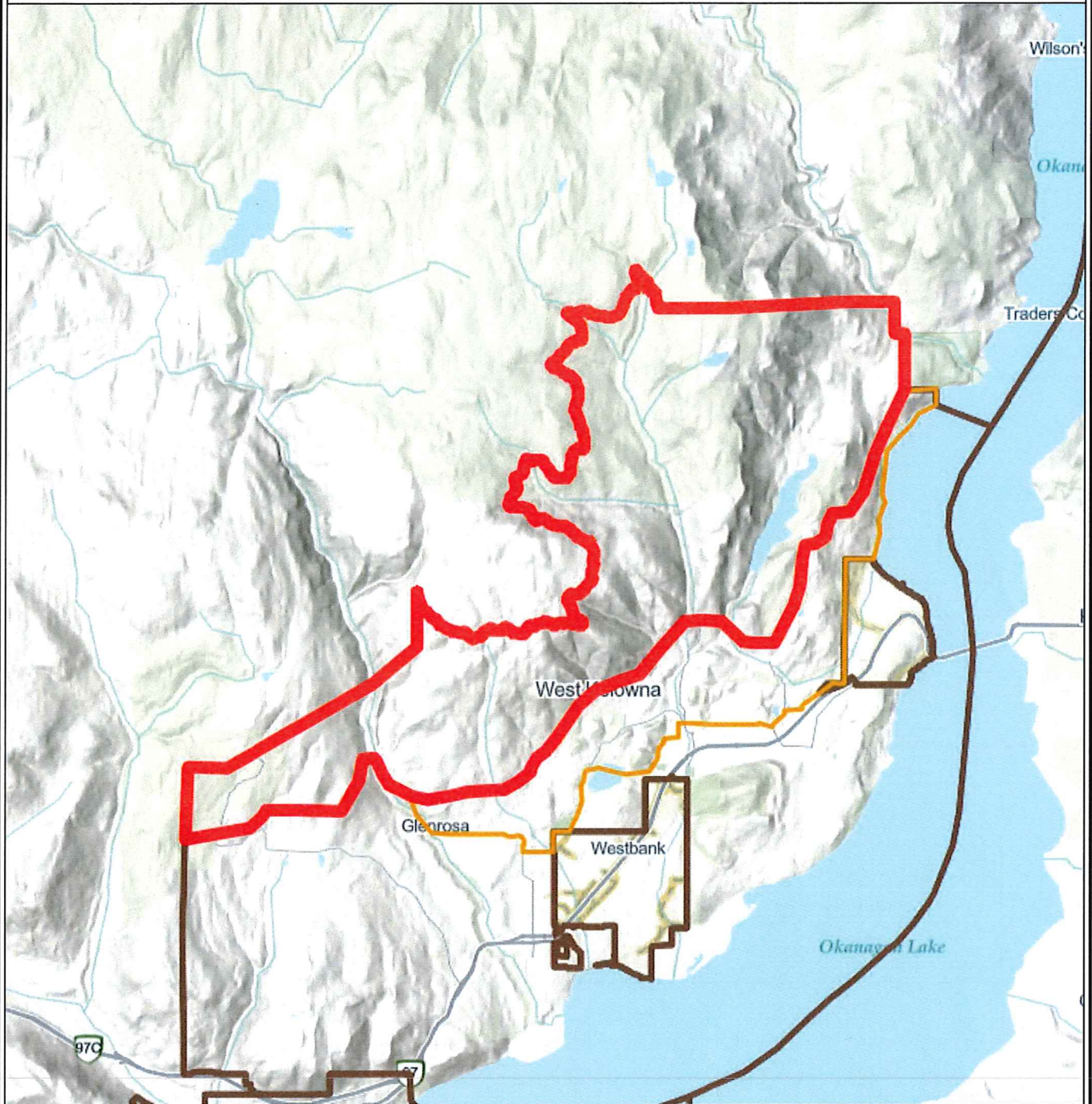
- You must leave the area immediately
- Register at the ESS Reception Centre online at <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/> or in person at 2760 Cameron Road in West Kelowna
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family; take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (i.e. medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available
- Take pets in pet kennels or on leash
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service
