WHEREAS: Notice to Community Members of an EVACUATION ORDER On July 13, 2023, at 16:30 the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation Band Council issued a Declaration of a State of Local Emergency to implement an evacuation order for the Lhoosk'uz Dené Territory due to being advised of the imminent danger of the current wildfire emergency. On July 18, 2023, the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation Band Council rescinds the Evacuation Order; however, an Evacuation alert stays in effect.

NOWTHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: the Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation members can return to their home community of Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation.



## **EVACUATION RESCIND**

## Lhoosk'uz Dené Territory

July 18, 2023 11:30am

The Evacuation Order, pursuant to <u>[Section 12 (1) of the BC Emergency Program Act / Band Council]</u> issued on July 13, 2023 to the Lhoosk'uz Dené Territory has been rescinded.

## **Evacuation Alert remains in effect**

An Evacuation Order may need to be reissued; however, if that is deemed necessary, the Evacuation Order process will re-commence.

## WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Fill the gas tank of personal vehicles
- Bring a minimum of three days of food and essential supplies (e.g. medications, pet supplies) with you as local grocery stores may not yet have adequate stock
- If your animals or livestock have been relocated, call [contact number] to coordinate their safe return
