

STATE OF ALERT to RESCIND

Date: August 9, 2023

WHEREAS the Nechako Southeast Area Fires in and around Nadleh Whut'en First Nation are no longer posing a direct threat to people and property;

AND WHEREAS this *Wildfire Emergency* no longer requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 14 (2) (ii) of the *Emergency Program Act* (RS, 1996, Chap 111) that a state of local emergency no longer exists in *Seaspunkut (IR # 4) and Ormond Lake (IR # 7 & IR #8)* and is therefore cancelled effective this August 9, 2023 at 0700 hrs.

The Nadleh Whut'en First Nation Community has been advised that the imminent risk of danger to life and property in our area has diminished at this time.

The Evacuation Order, pursuant to Nadleh Whut'en First Nation Government is therefore rescinded. An Evacuation Alert / Order may need to be reinstated, therefore the process would re-commence.
