Description

The Evacuation Order, pursuant to **Section 12 (1) of the BC Emergency Program Act / Band Council** issued at **August 19, 2023 at 17:00 hours** to the area(s) **ALIB IR#5** has been rescinded and downgraded to an evacuation alert as of September 1, 2023 at 08:00.

Instructions

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Bring a minimum of three days of food and essential supplies (e.g. medications, pet supplies) with you as local grocery stores may not yet have adequate stock.
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents or pets, and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Make arrangements to stay with family or friends (if possible).
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members.
- **Please be advised that you are returning to a home with no power. Power restoration is still to be determined. ESS Supports are still valid- if you received your ESS extension, you can continue to stay in your hotel and utilize your lodging vouchers until the expiry date shown on them.**
