- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents or pets, and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Make arrangements to stay with family or friends (if possible).
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members.
- Please be advised that you are returning to a home with no power. Power
 restoration is still to be determined. ESS Supports are still valid- if you received
 your ESS extension, you can continue to stay in your hotel and utilize your lodging
 vouchers until the expiry date shown on them.
