

EVACUATION ALERT – RESCIND

Glacier Creek Fire G90700 25 Km North of Atlin – Unincorporated Stikine

June 30, 2025, at 16:00 HRS

The Evacuation Alert issued by the Province of British Columbia due to the threats to health, safety, and the welfare of persons because of the Glacier Creek Wildfire (R90700) is no longer required and is **rescinded** immediately.

This **Evacuation Alert** is **rescinded** for the following areas:

- Approximately 25 km North of Atlin along the Atlin Highway. Commencing at the intersection of Atlin Lake and Glacier Creek,
- thence in an easterly direction along Glacier Creek to a point 1800m to the east of Atlin Highway,
- thence in a southerly direction along the 1800m offset from Atlin Highway to a point due east from the most southerly point of Cliff Lake,
- thence due west to the shoreline of Atlin Lake, thence in a northerly direction along the shoreline of Atlin lake to the point of commencement.
