

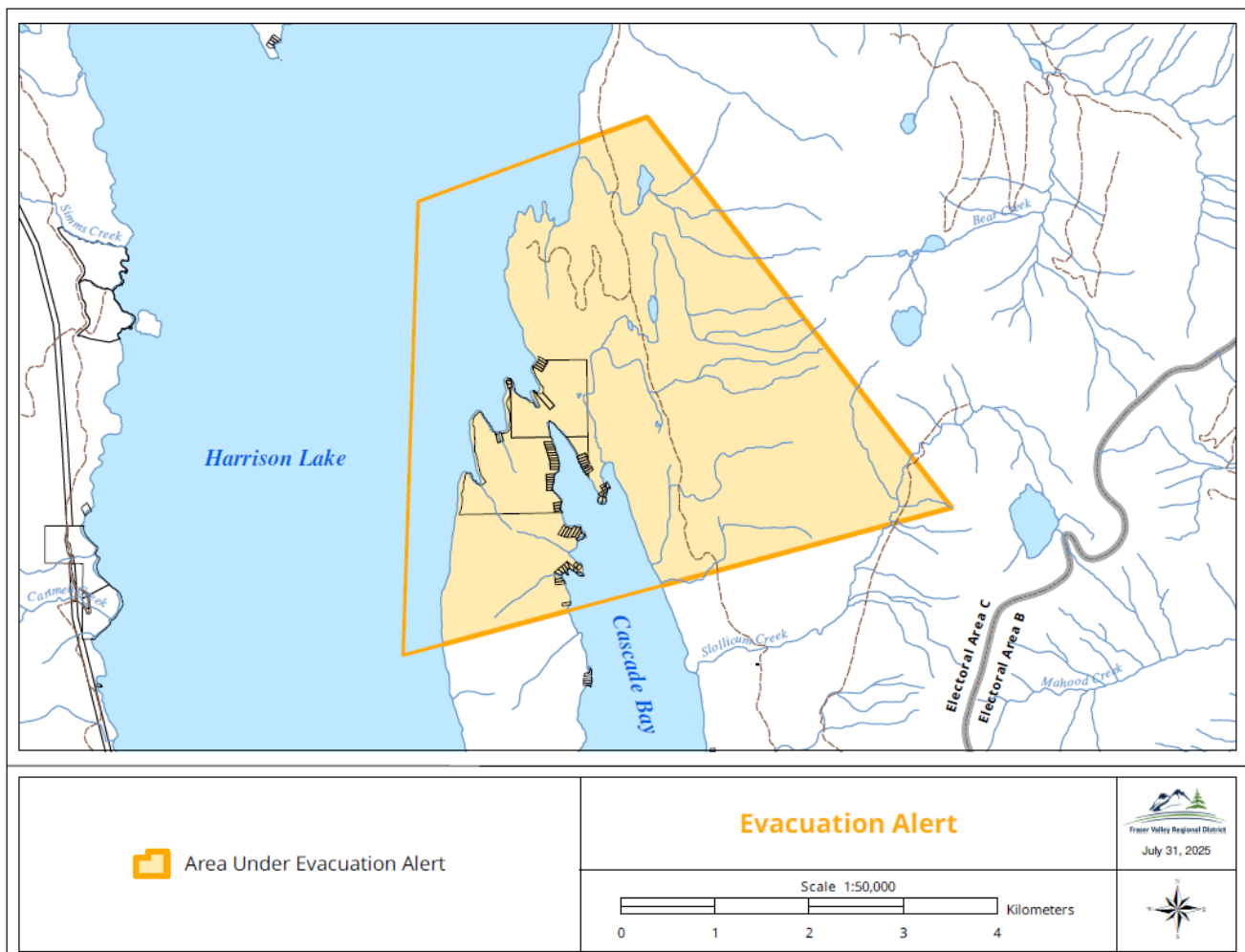
EVACUATION ALERT

July 31, 2025 10:42 am

Electoral Area C – North Cascade Bay Area, Harrison Lake

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Fraser Valley Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) because of the potential danger to life and safety due to the Bear Creek Wildfire (V11110). You are not required to evacuate at this time but you must be prepared to evacuate on short notice. Failure to do so may result in you or your family not having the supplies you require, such as medications.

The Fraser Valley Regional District has issued an **Evacuation Alert** for the following areas shown on the map below:



The evacuation alert includes the following Locations:

- Cascade Peninsula Recreation Site: 15km, Harrison East Forest Service Rd, Harrison Hot Springs

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and choose a meeting place outside the evacuation alert area, should an evacuation order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as: government issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance, identification licenses, credit and mortgage info, and emergency contact numbers), and immediate care needs for dependents and pets, and if space and time permits, keepsakes for quick departure
- Prepare to move disabled persons (with mobility aids & supports required to maintain independence), children, elderly and immobile neighbours
- Prepare supplies, vet records, and containment needs for pets
- Implement a plan to move livestock to safety
- Arrange for transport of your household members
- Arrange accommodation for your household members and pets
- In the event of an evacuation order, Emergency Support Services (ESS) sites may be activated for the purposes of family reunification, referrals to essential service providers, and Group Lodging
- In the event of an evacuation order, register with the Canadian Red Cross to be notified when services become available
- Monitoring credible news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of ESS Sites
