The Evacuation Alert issued at 2025-08-27 at 0300, by the Regional District of Central Okanagan Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) for the District of Peachland has been rescinded as follows.

- All addresses on Stuart Crescent
- All addresses on Sherburn Road
- All addresses on Ferguson Place
- 6532 - 6642 Renfrew Road
- 6575, 6602, 6633, and 6696 Hwy 97
- All units located at 6663 Hwy 97
- Hwy 97 from Hardy St. extending 1km north

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:


- Fill the gas tank of personal vehicles
