HAZARD NOTICE

Issued: 15 January 2025

A Hazard Notice has been issued by the Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine for all areas adjacent to the Kispiox River due to risk of flooding caused by ice jams.

People in the area are advised to exercise caution and be prepared for changing conditions. Monitoring of the situation will continue and updates will be provided.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- **Avoid riverbanks and streams** in the Kispiox River area, as unpredictable water levels increase the risk of dangerous conditions.
- **Relocate any recreational vehicles, equipment, or property** from flood-prone areas to higher ground immediately.
- **Stay informed** by regularly checking the RDKS website for information updates at rdks.bc.ca.
