



EVACUATION ORDER

North side of the 300 Block and 400 Blocks of Green Avenue West, within the City of Penticton

Date: 05-28-2026

Whereas a state of local emergency was declared on 05-08-2026 by The City of Penticton pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to a large structure fire at a construction site within the City of Penticton;

And whereas Section 107 (1)(c) and (d) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* authorizes requiring evacuations in relation to a declared state of local emergency, making arrangements for the adequate care and protection of evacuated persons and animals, and controlling travel to or from an area;

And whereas the “Green Avenue Fire” is a significant threat to the health, safety, and welfare of persons, such that an evacuation and controlling travel is necessary to minimize threats;

This **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the City of Penticton and is **effective as of 05-28-2026** for the following properties and as shown on the attached map (Attachment A):
