EVACUATION ALERT EXPANSION

Fiftynine Creek Wildfire

July 23, 2026, 1130 hours

An expanded **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District due to the Fiftynine Creek Wildfire. The original Evacuation Alert (Alert No. JO-069) issued by the Thompson-Nicola Regional District is hereby **replaced** by this Evacuation Alert, effective as of July 23, 2026.

This expanded Evacuation Alert is now in place for approximately **105** addressed properties in Electoral Area "E" (Bonaparte Plateau).

Impacted expanded areas are as follows (12 addressed properties):

- **5930 – 6800 Big Bar Rd;**
- **10780 – 10843 Jesmond Rd; and**
- **Any other properties as outlined in the attached map.**

This Evacuation Alert is in place to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to an Evacuation Order; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

What You Should Do:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be issued while separated.
- Pack essential items for quick departure, such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents or pets, and, if time and space permits, keepsakes.
- Prepare a grab-and-go bag with clothing, toiletries, food, water, and medications.
- Arrange to stay with family or friends (if possible).
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/ or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move large animals and livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- If you are a livestock producer, ensure that you have your Premise ID in the event that you require support should an Evacuation Order be issued.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles to be used in case of an Evacuation Order.
