



EVACUATION ALERT FOR THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON

July 15, 2026 23:30 hrs.

Based on recommendations from the BC Wildfire Services (BCWS), an Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Village of Pemberton due to the Signal Hill Wildfire (V30852) burning out of control in the Pemberton area.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Village of Pemberton has issued an Evacuation Alert for the Village of Pemberton. Please review the attached map for detailed information.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advanced notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

**Additional evacuation route and emergency support details will be provided
if an evacuation becomes necessary.**

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

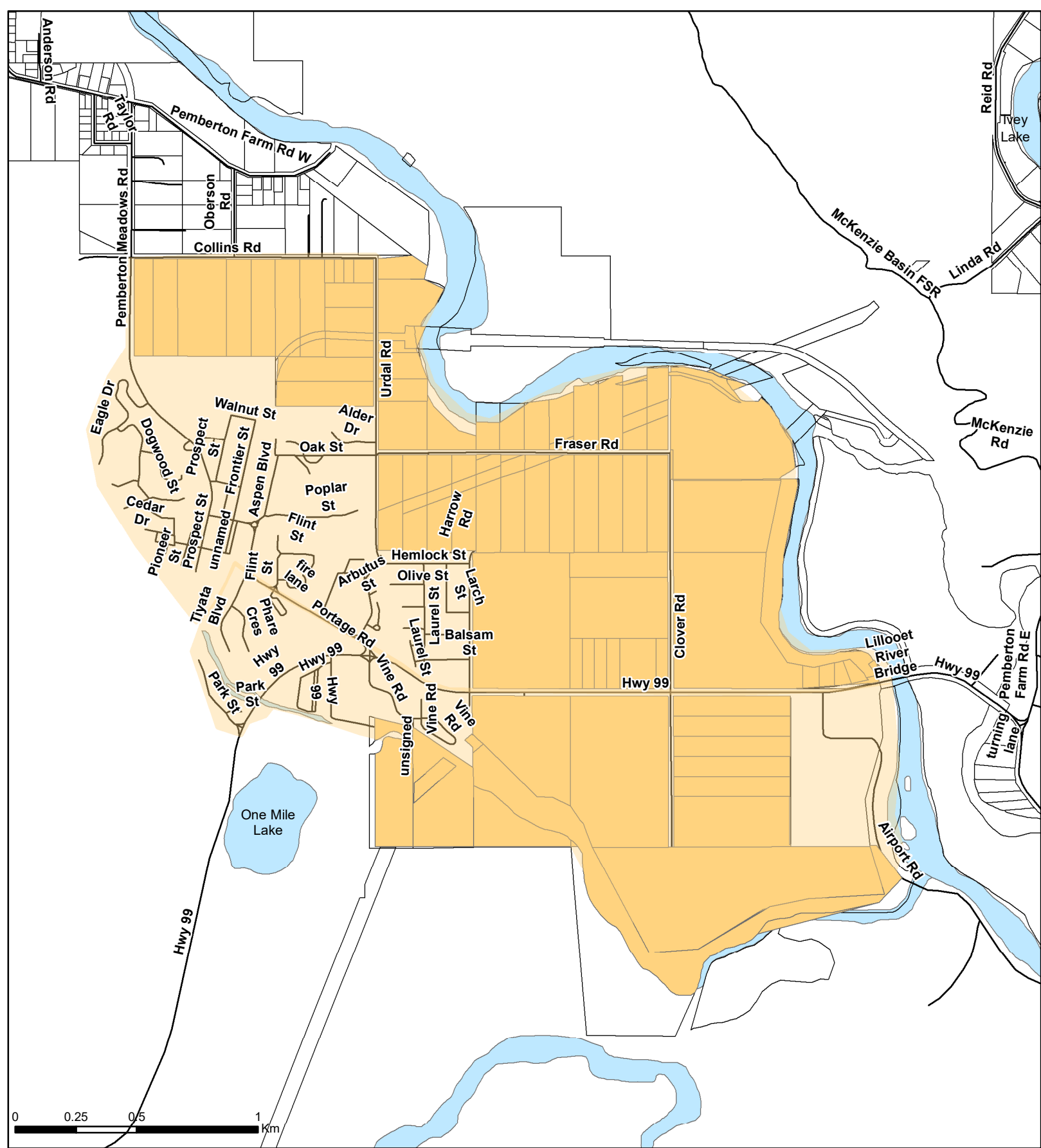
Upon notification of an ALERT, you should be prepared for the Evacuation Order by:

- Pre-register for Emergency Support Services online at: <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside of the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g., insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependants and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move people who may need additional time to evacuate, children and/or neighbours who would require assistance.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation and accommodations for all your household members, if possible, and fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.



- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.
