August 6, 2026

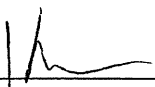
Whereas the Chief and Council are the duly elected leadership of the Ts'kw'aylaxw First Nation and as such:

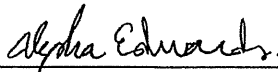

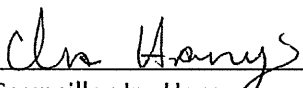

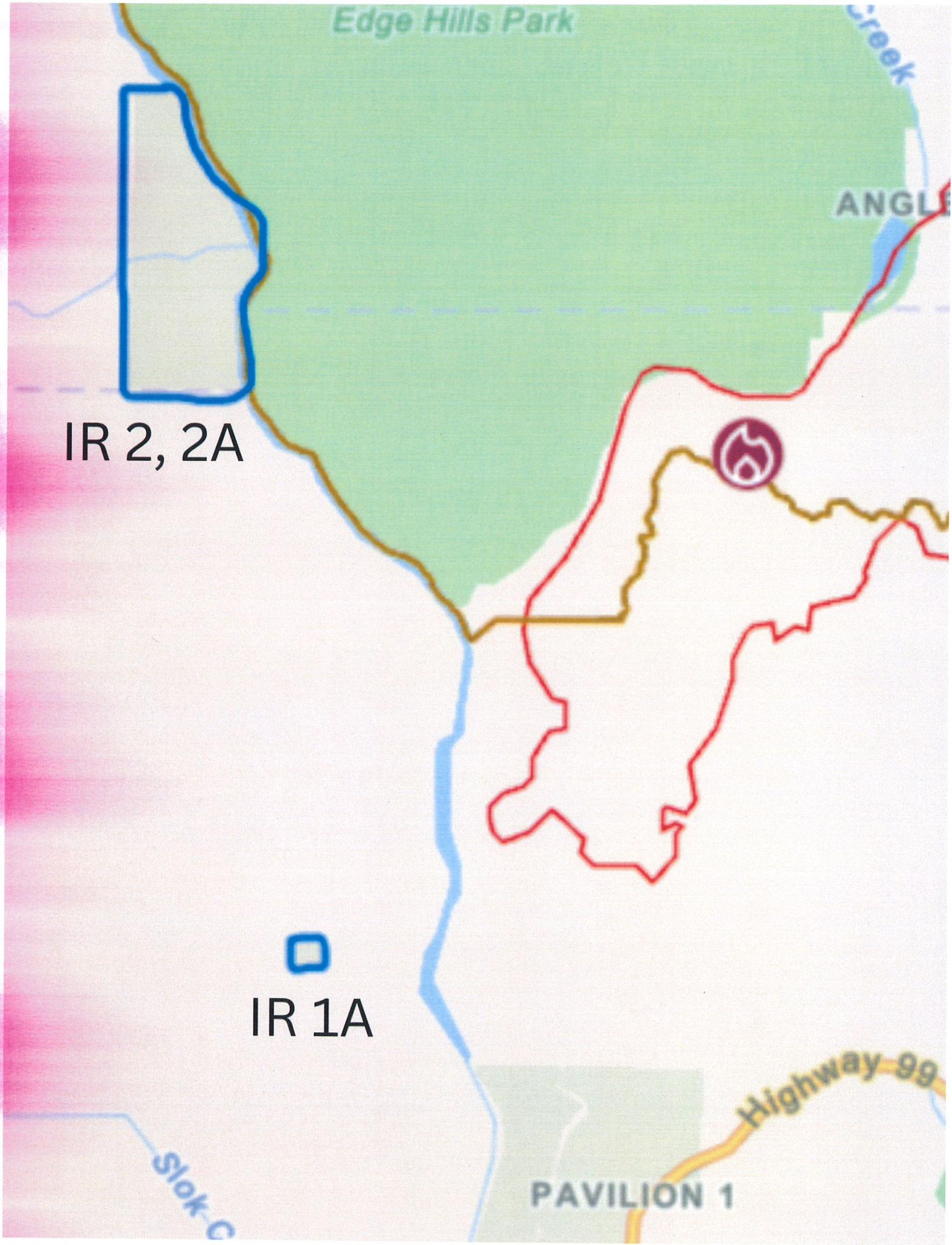

Subject: Notification of Evacuation Order – Ts'kw'aylaxw First Nation (Pavilion) IR 1A, IR 2, and IR 2A Along the west side of the Fraser River.

Dear BC Wildfire Service, EMCR, Squamish-Lillooet Regional District (SLRD), and Thompson-Nicola Regional District (TNRD) Representatives,

Please accept this email as formal notification that **Ts'kw'aylaxw First Nation (Pavilion)** will be issuing an **Evacuation Order** for the following reserve lands located on the west side of the Fraser River:

- IR No. 1A
- IR No. 2 (Leons Creek)
- IR No. 2A (Leons Creek)

The purpose of this Order is to restrict **non-local traffic and backcountry recreational use** within these areas due to current wildfire conditions and associated public safety concerns.

Please note that **there are currently no residents, permanent or temporary, within the affected Evacuation Order area**. As such, no resident evacuations are required at this time. This Order is being implemented as a proactive public safety measure to control access and reduce potential risks to the public and emergency response operations.

This email is intended as a **notification only** to ensure partner agencies are aware of the Order and can update their situational awareness and records accordingly.

Should any of your agencies wish to discuss the situation further or request a coordination call, we would be pleased to arrange one. However, at this time, the issuance of the Order is limited to restricting non-local access and backcountry use within the three identified reserve areas.
